

TC-TAC Update – April 1, 2016 Meeting

The Tri-County Technical Advisory Committee (TC-TAC) held their monthly meeting on April 1st here at the Kirkwood Community Services Building to discuss several important issues.

The Committee decided to ask the proponents, Vail and Kirkwood Resort Development, to revise certain aspects of the Specific Plan 10-Year Review. The Committee asked that the public comments be addressed and that a Scope of Work be brought back at the next meeting. Public comments included:

- Clarity as to responsibility
- Absence of review of some mitigations
- Employee Housing
- Street Sweeping
- KCA as review authority
- On-street parking (Kirkwood Meadows Drive)
- Caltrans – traffic evaluations, roadway improvements
- Noxious Weeds

TC-TAC decided to table the issue of the role of the District and the United States Forest Service as ex-officio members until further discussions take place between the County Planners.

TC-TAC decided to allow the meetings to be televised and to provide a teleconference line on a trial basis.

Finally, the Committee chose to move the date for TC-TAC meetings to the second Friday of every month to generate additional public participation.

The next TC-TAC meeting is scheduled for Friday, May 13th at 10:00am at the Kirkwood Community Services Building. The public is encouraged to attend.
