Kirkwood Meadows Public Utility District reminds the public that the coronavirus (or COVID-19) has no impact on the quality or supply of your domestic drinking water (tap water). We want to reassure our customers that your tap water remains safe to drink.

According to the Center for Disease Control, conventional water treatment methods that use filtration and disinfection, such as those in KMPUD drinking water system, removes or inactivates the virus that causes COVID-19.
