Do you have household hazardous waste that you need to dispose of? You can drop it off for free at the Buena Vista Transfer Station in Lone.



**Drop-off dates this summer are July 7, 21 and August 4, 18.**

**Accepted:** paints and thinners, chemicals, household and automotive batteries, medications, and fluorescent tubes and bulbs.

## Fish Stocking Update

With the snow melting, flowers emerging, and long, warm summer days, it's time to grab your fishing rod and head out to the lakes around Kirkwood! The District had another successful fish stocking day on Friday, June 29<sup>th</sup>, just in time for the 4<sup>th</sup> of July Holiday. The District was able to plant about 1,820 pounds of trophy fish and about 775 pounds of "catchable" fish, totaling 2,595 pounds of Rainbow Trout stocked into Caples Lake & Silver Lake combined. This is the fourteenth and final year for the District's Fish Enhancement Fund, which we have been able to do for so long thanks to the help of the El Dorado Irrigation District and Desert Springs Trout Farm in Summer Lake, Oregon. We have enjoyed the opportunity to play a role in the fish stocking activities for the Kirkwood area. Good Luck & Happy Fishing!

### Annual 5K/10K Run & Kids Fun Run

The Annual 5K/10K & Kids Fun Run is planned for the morning of **September 1st** beginning at 9am in front of The Lodge. This fun event has been taking place in Kirkwood each Labor Day weekend for 37 years. Presented by the Kirkwood Volunteer Fire Department, the 10K trail adventure run follows a single track and a dirt road 3-miles up the mountain to an elevation of 8,500 feet.
