Work Experience:

- Operate a trackless snowblower, backhoe, and loader.
- Tier 4 - must be able to operate an RPM blower.
- Work closely with Supervisor/Foreman in the de-icing and removal of snow from roads, driveways, and parking lots for various residential and commercial properties according to the specified contracts.
- Proficiently and safely use snow removal equipment such as shovels, plows, snow blowers, and other power or manually operated tools and equipment used to perform snow removal.
- Maintain and care for company provided equipment, tools and vehicles.

- Assist with the installation of snow stakes.
